Muhammad Ben Muda is currently Adviser at the Commonwealth Business Council (CBC) in London.

Before joining the CBC, Mr Muda worked for the Malaysian Ministry of Foreign Affairs from 1975–2002 and during this period, he took up diplomatic appointments at the Malaysian embassies in South Korea and the Soviet Union as well as the High Commissions in Namibia and the United Kingdom. Ben retired from the diplomatic service at the end of 2002.

Prior to joining the CBC in 2006, Mr Muda worked for the Commonwealth Partnership for Technology Management (CPTM) in London.

Mr Muda was also lecturer at the University of Malaya and International Islamic University Malaysia. He obtained BA (Hons) from Victoria University of Wellington, NZ, MA from University of Salford and PhD from University of London.

His current activities include research on the Commonwealth and international organizations, and he has contributed articles to the academic journal *The Round Table – The Commonwealth Journal of International Affairs*.

Mr Muda is currently Chairman of the ASEAN-UK Business Forum (AUBF), Member of the Board of Trustees of Malaysia-Europe Forum (MEF), and Member of the Royal African Society.
